CSN Hospitality Program Prepares Incarcerated Students for Workforce Reentry

Nov. 1, 2024 — The College of Southern Nevada and the Nevada Department of Corrections will host a showcase and completion ceremony for students enrolled in CSN's Hospitality Program at the Florence McClure Women's Correctional Center. The event will feature a job fair for students within three to six months of release, giving them an opportunity to participate in job interviews with potential employers.

Made possible through a \$1.4 million grant from the Governor's Office and the Nevada Office of Workforce Innovation, this event will demonstrate the skills and workforce readiness of CSN's incarcerated students. The ceremony will highlight competencies in Hospitality and Tourism as well as Business Administration, equipping students with essential tools for reentry and professional success.
