

CSN Media Fest Set for March 31–April 2

The event highlights student talent and industry connections

March 2, 2026 — As Las Vegas continues to grow as a destination for film and digital production, CSN will host its annual Media Fest for a Three-day event at North Las Vegas campus.

Media Fest brings together students, alumni, faculty and industry professionals for screenings, workshops, panels, gallery exhibits and vendor showcases. Major photography and production brands, including Canon, Nikon, Sony, Fuji, and Godox are expected to have a presence, offering demonstrations, raffles and contests. Students and community members will have the opportunity to meet and ask questions of working professionals, build industry connections and gain insight into career pathways in film, photography, videography and digital media.
