Herbers brings more than 25 years of experience in collegiate athletics, most recently serving as Director of Development for Athletics at Utah Valley University. He has also served in similar capacities at colleges and universities in Minnesota, Arizona, and Washington.

“We’re thrilled to bring in someone with Jason’s experience in managing and leading successful athletics divisions,” said CSN President Stacy Klippenstein. “He’s a perfect fit for us, recognizing that student-athletes are students first, and their success in life is our mission.”

Herbers will lead the college’s nationally recognized athletics division, with nine men’s and women’s sports in total and a tradition of student success. He begins his tenure June 15.
